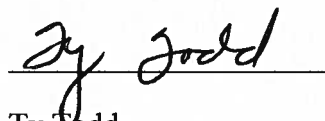
The Oklahoma Department of Transportation hereby provides its support to Alcatel-Lucent's application for an expedited experimental special temporary authority ("Experimental STA") regarding its proposed temporary operation in 700 MHz Band 14 spectrum to demonstrate Long Term Evolution ("LTE") equipment in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma for use at the Oklahoma Department of Transportation and supporting State Agencies Meeting between June 20, 2011 and July 10, 2011. The demonstration will show LTE broadband capabilities that will ultimately protect the life, health, or property of first responders and the citizens of Oklahoma.

The demonstration will show how mission-critical information can be exchanged in real-time, anytime, anywhere. The demonstration will emphasize the use of Media Portal (Live Video Streaming) and two-way video conferencing. The use of live video will allow first responders in the field to one day receive live surveillance feeds and on-scene video that will provide a common operating picture and access to information from the field, enhancing both incident response and first responder safety. Finally, the demonstration will show how

broadband networks will allow for the secure, easy and interoperable sharing of information (voice, video and multi-media data) among first responders.

In sum, we support Alcatel-Lucent's expedited Experimental STA, as it will provide the State of Oklahoma the ability to show first responders in our community 700 MHZ public safety broadband capabilities, which will assist in protecting the life, health, or property of our citizens.
