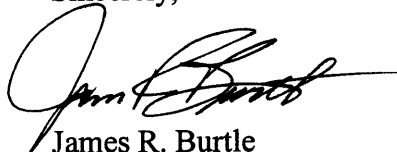
Dear Jake Holland,

This refers to application, File No. 0243-EX-ST-2004, for an experimental authorization.

You are advised that the Commission is unable to grant your application for the facilities requested. Harmful interference to existing licensees is anticipated. Should the applicant decide to reapply, it is recommended that the following be provided: (1) An analysis identifying the probable interference source(s). (2) An analysis showing that the proposed increase in power will not cause interference to the identified interference source(s). (3) Specific consent from the licensee of the station identified as the interference source(s). (4) Evidence that prior coordination in accordance with 101.103(d) has been completed with respect to all potentially affected licensed stations. (5) Concurrence from the local SBE coordinator.
