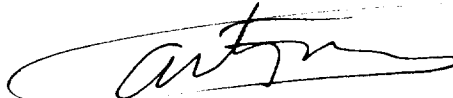
Pursuant to Part 5 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 5 (1989), the Allen-Bradley Company ("Allen-Bradley") was granted an experimental authorization, Call Sign KC2XAQ, File Number 1171-EX-PL-89, effective October 23, 1989. This authorization will expire December 1, 1991.
