Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) The station identification requirements of Section 5.152 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (3) Operation in the 1850-1910 or 1930-1990 MHz band requires prior frequency coordination with 2 GHz microwave users and consent of PCS licensees to avoid interference.
- (4) Operation in the 1910-1930 MHz band requires coordination with UTAM, Inc. pursuant to Section 15.307 of the Commission's Rules.
- (5) Operation in the 824-849 or 869-894 MHz band requires consent of local cellular licensee(s) to avoid interference.
- (6) Power and emission must conform to Parts 22, 24, and 90 of the Commission's rules.
- (7) Prior to operation, licensee must coordinate with the existing and future licensed users in the area of operation to avoid interference.
