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Message:

1) Please be informed that in Item 5C, the area of operation is within the entire USA rather than "South of Line A".

2) Further Explanation On Requesting Approval OF Entire USA:

2.1) Alligator is a radio manufacturing company providing MAS radio equipment as well as system design services for our customers through out the entire USA. Frequently we have to put radios in use for life demos, trade shows as well as on site feasibility tests and field strength measurements.

Typically, we attend about 10 trade shows per year. Sales demonstrations on the average of 30 times per year. On site feasibility tests or field strength measurements about 16 times per year. In order to avoid interfering other MAS users, our employees are instructed to use spectrum analyzer to sweep the sites prior to selecting a test frequency or check with frequency coordinating companies to locate an unused frequency. Further precautions are also taken such as decreasing the transmit power to lowest usable levels.

Since there is no way our company can predict the exact locations and the exact dates the above activities may take place, we respectfully request that a temporary license be granted to Alligator Communication for the entire USA.
