This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

Special Conditions:

- (1) Amdocs, Inc must maintain operation separation from grandfathered earth stations as defined in Part 90, Sub-part Z, or coordinate an agreement with grandfathered earth station licensees prior to operation in 3550-3700 MHz band.
- (2) Amdocs, Inc must consult the ULS database to ensure that its planned operation will not cause harmful interference to any existing registered stations in the 3650-3700 MHz band, and notify the registered users of its planned operation in the proposed geographic area.
- (3) Amdocs, Inc should be aware that the band 3500-3650 MHz is allocated for federal services, and it should have no expectations of automatic approval in this band in future submissions.
