This is a request for an experimental station license to be used in developmental testing, pursuant to section 5.202 (d) and (h) of the Commission's rules, at the Bell Labs location in Whippany, NJ. The frequencies involved are a subset of the frequencies used for wireless telecommunications in Europe. Commercial operations using these frequencies are not anticipated in the United States. However, in order to develop and test this equipment here at our laboratories, it will be necessary to radiate on these frequencies in the vicinity of the Whippany Bell Labs facility.
