Special Conditions:

- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) All customers participating in the experiment shall be informed that this operation is for experimental purposes only and can be cancelled at any time.
- (3) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (4) All transmitting and/or receiving equipment used in the study shall be owned by the licensee.

Special Conditions:

- (5) Licensee is required to ensure that trial devices are either rendered inoperable or retrieved by them from trial participants at the conclusion of the trial. Licensee is required to notify trial participants in advance that operation of the trial device is subject to this condition.
- (6) Licensee shall be aware that FSS earth stations are licensed above 3700 MHz and if any interference occurs, the experimental licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (7) Licensee shall maintain operation separation from the grandfathered earth stations as defined in Part 90, Sub-part Z, or coordinate an agreement with the grandfathered earth station licensees prior to operation in 3650-3700 MHz band.
- (8) Licensee shall consult the ULS database to ensure that the operation will not cause harmful interference to any existing registered stations in the 3650-3700 MHz band, and notify the registered users in the proposed geographic areas prior to operation in this band.
- (9) Non-approved equipment must be labeled.
- (10) Non-approved equipment must be retrieved.
- (11) The frequency band 3550-3650 MHz is not allowed to operate in designated exclusion zones. The requested location falls within the Exclusion Zone defined in the NTIA Fast Track Report (NTIA Technical Report TR-15-517: 3.5 GHz Exclusion Zone Analyses and Methodology).
