- (14) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by the U.S. Government; contract number HDTRA1-14-D-0003-HDTRA1-18-F-0059. The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.
- (15) Applied Research Associates, Inc. must schedule all operations through the WSMR Survivability, Vulnerability and Assessment Directorate as a WSMR Range Mission. Final authority to radiate is contingent upon successful scheduling and de-confliction of both airspace and spectrum with other area operations by the WSMR ISM.
