Thank you for talking with Andy Anderson and myself on Monday. The FCC referred us to you regarding the 2305 to 2690 MHz spectrum. The FCC told us we need a report of prior coordination with you (Army Frequency Management Office) before our experimental license application can proceed with the FCC.

We design and manufacture antennas for the commercial wireless industry. We are applying for a site license for an outdoor antenna test range located at: North 39 deg 47 minutes 08 seconds, West 105 deg 07 minutes 34 seconds in Wheat Ridge, Colorado near Denver. We are applying for a maximum ERP of 2000 Watts. If this is too high of power please let us know what the maximum limit could be. Our test range (source to antenna under test) will be located in an area less than 300 by 300 feet and will be point to point testing using a directive source to minimize interference.

Thank you for your assistance in this matter. If you need more clarification or description please let us know. We look forward to

hearing from you.
