Please accept this letter of concurrence from Aviation Spectrum Resources Inc. (ASRI) for use of the following frequencies for the purpose of datalink ramp testing:

131.550 MHz (13K0A2D)	500 mW Output power
136.700 MHz (14K0G1D)	5 Watts Output power

Locations:

- 1) Greenville, TX (Majors Airport) 2 km radius of 33 04 30 N / 096 04 35 W
- 2) Annapolis, MD (2551 Riva Road/ARINC) 2 km of 38 58 35 N / 076 32 58 W

This concurrence is conditioned upon the following:

- Only the emissions specified may be transmitted on the respective frequencies.
- There shall not be any harmful interference, or unnecessary traffic with detrimental performance effects, to existing datalink networks or adjacent frequency voice users because of this concurrence.
- Radios operated on the above frequencies shall only connect to existing datalink networks operated by currently licensed VHF service providers.
- An emergency stop contact is provided to affected users.
