Tony, confirming our telephone call of this afternoon:

On October 19th, ArrayComm filed a paper application for an Experimental license to operate in and around San Jose. This modifies an existing authorization that ArrayComm now holds to operate in San Diego.

Subsequent examination revealed that the Table in Item 4 of the application is incorrect. Exhibit 1 which accompanies the application is correct; the Table needs to be amended to conform.

Your advice is to wait until the application is forwarded from the bank to the FCC. At that time you will notify us, and by letter or email we will supply the proper information. This should occur in ten days to two weeks.
