- (3) Operations must be scheduled either as a WSMR range mission, through the WSMR sponsor or with the WSMR DOD area frequency coordinator (DOD-AFC). Scheduling and coordination with the WSMR DOD-AFC shall be at least 96 hours prior to start of operations, and shall be via email to usarmy.wsmr.imcomcentral.list.dodafc@mail.mil.
- (4) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by U.S. Army TARDEC contract no. W15QKN-14-9-1001. The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.
- (5) The locations for the proposed testing at Herndon, VA and Livermore, CA fall within exclusion zones designated to protect federal government users of the requested spectrum.
