AST&Science has determined that it will have the Lithuanian Agency for Science, Innovation and Technology (MITA) register the BlueWalker 1 spacecraft. Lithuania (in addition to Papua New Guinea) has issued a space license for the BlueWalker 1.

Therefore, AST&Science is submitting today a letter from MITA indicating its willingness to register the space craft with the UN Office of Outer Space Affairs. It also is submitting an orbital debris mitigation plan, which it believes satisfies the requests of Section 5.64 and prior Commission correspondence.

Note that the MITA letter and the orbital debris plan reference NanoAviontika LLC (also referred to as NanoAvionics). AST&Science has a majority, controlling interest in NanoAviontika LLC, which is based in Lithuania and is the entity that is building the spacecraft.
