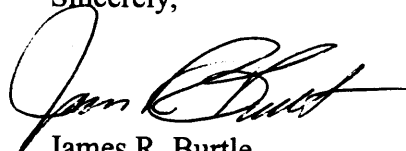
This refers to application, File No. 0441-EX-ST-2000, for an experimental license.
