Special Conditions:

- (1) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (2) Licensee is required to coordinate operations with existing microwave users in the area to avoid interference.
- (3) The occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (4) Experimental station shall use the minimum power level necessary to establish communications links to minimize potential interference to licensed users.
- (5) Licensee must avoid pointing the transmitting antenna main beam gain within 10 degrees of any point on the geostationary orbital arc while transmitting signals in the 27.5-28.35 GHz and 37-40 GHz bands.
- (6) Licensee shall ensure that the transmitting fixed station antenna(s) main beam gain tip down when possible and avoid pointing above the horizon to protect satellite stations.
- (7) This authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future experimental satellite earth station applications.
- (8) No automatic renewal for operations in the 27.5-28.35 GHz and 37-40 GHz bands.
