Special Conditions:

- (1) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (2) Licensee is required to coordinate operations with existing microwave users in the area to avoid interference.
- (3) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (4) Operation is subject to prior coordination with the local Society of Broadcast Engineers, Inc. (SBE) frequency coordinator. Consult the list at http://freq.sbe.org/pdf_files/coordinators.pdf to find the appropriate coordinator.
- (5) The occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (6) Notification must be provided to the NASA Wallops Flight Facility (WFF) Spectrum Manager, Felipe Arroyo 757.824.1623 or felipe.arroyo-1@nasa.gov, at least 7 days prior to operations to allow de-confliction of sounding rocket telemetry operations.
- (7) The authorized station must be in compliance with environmental requirement set forth in Section 1.1307 of the Commission's Rules.
- (8) Operations are on a non-interference basis (NIB) and shall not cause harmful interference to, and shall not claim protection from, interference caused to it by any other lawfully operating station and it shall cease transmission(s) immediately upon notice of such interference and notify the FCC in writing.
- (9) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by Office of Naval Research contract no. N00014-12-C-0671. The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.
