Subject: Additional Information Request

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Message:

AFS is requesting a maximum altitude expansion from 5,000 to 10,000 feet AMSL due to the ATC restrictions on the test flights in this area of operations. Minimum altitude for flight ops is 4,000 ft. The 5,000 ft limitation on the experimental license allows for a very narrow 1,000 ft band in which to operate. This is a test pilot request to allow for safer and more efficient operations, decreasing pilot workload.

As always, the NASA Goddard Space Flight Center POCs listed in the original grant will be notified in advance of AFS flight operations.
