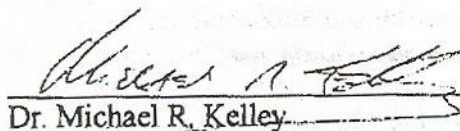

Axcera agrees to operate at a power level that will not cause interference to the Foundation's C Group ITFS broadcast signal outside of the convention center.

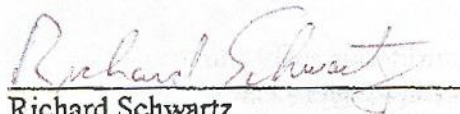

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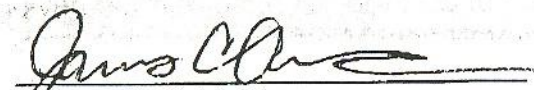

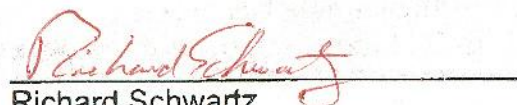
