For instance, 51.8 - 52.2 MHz is allocated to the amateur radio service in the U.S. Has any coordination with ARRL or any other responsible amateur group been performed? Next, 76.8 - 77.2 MHz is allocated to television. Are there any TV stations in the area that could be affected? Similarly, 92.3 - 92.7 MHz is allocated to FM radio. What radio station could be affected?
