Special Conditions:

- (1) Operation in the 1850-1910 or 1930-1990 MHz band requires prior frequency coordination with 2 GHz microwave users and consent of PCS licensees to avoid interference.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (4) Operation is subject to prior coordination with Part 22, Part 24, Part 27, Part 90 and Part 101 licensees to avoid interference.
- (5) BAE and DARPA acknowledge that the 1710-1755 MHz band is being transferred to the FCC for next generation cellular phone in the US and will not be available to the DoD within CONUS.
