- (1) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) Operation is subject to prior coordination with the Society of Broadcast Engineers, Inc. (SBE); ATTN: Executive Director; 9102 North Meridian Street, Suite 305; Indianapolis, IN 46260; telephone, (866) 632-4222; FAX, (317) 846-9120; e-mail, executivedir @ sbe.org; information, www.sbe.org.
- (4) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (5) No operation is permitted to transmit in any public safety frequencies listed under Part 90.20 unless coordinated with the licensed public safety entity.
- (6) Prior to commencing any operations in the frequencies below, the applicant must obtain consent from the following within 100 miles of the contours of the testing area: Location & Monitoring Service licensees (902-928 MHz)
- (7) Operation is subject to prior coordination with the existing and future Fixed Microwave Service licensees in accordance with 47 CFR, Part 101.103(d).
- (8) Operation must be maintain separation from the incumbent, grandfathered fixed satellite service earth stations as defined in Part 90, Subpart Z.
- (9) The designated point-of-contact to terminate transmissions if interference occurs is Mr. George Moynihan at (603) 689-8630 and BAE Systems Emergency Services Center at (603) 885-3842.
- (10) Operation is subject to prior coordination with FAA.
- (11) Using the frequency band 2700-2900 MHz, transmissions are required to be blanked between 0-270 degrees reference to true North.
- (12) Renew the frequency 172 MHz is subject to prior coordination with Department of Justice. Point-of-contact Quan Vu at 202-598-2103 ; email quan.vu@usdoj.gov.

Special Conditions:

- (13) Operation is NOT PERMITTED using the frequency band 1400-1427 MHz and 1660.5-1668.4 MHz.
- (14) Use of this frequency band 1251-1850 MHz under the authority of this assignment is subject to further coordination with HQ USAF frequency coordinator, Alexandria, VA to ensure compatibility with existing uses.
- (15) Experimental use of the frequency band 123.125-123.575 MHz, 1435-1525 MHz and 2360-2395 MHz is secondary to, and must not interfere with, Flight Test operations. Licensee must coordinate with other users as necessary to minimize interference. Renewal of this License is subject to prior coordination with AFTRCC Frequency Advisory Committee, www.afttrcc.org.
