Special Conditions:

- (1) Assignment on 1030 MHz or in one of the bands 1215-1400, 2700-2900, or 9000-9200 MHz was coordinated prior to authorization with the FAA Eastern Coordinator, New York, NY. Use of frequencies under the authority of this assignment is subject to such further coordination with the FAA Eastern Coordinator, New York, NY, as necessary to ensure compatibility with existing uses.
- (2) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.
- (3) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (4) The PRR used by all equipment operating under the authority of this license shall be an average of 375 interrogations per second. The pulse repetition interval (PRI) shall be between 2400 and 2930 microseconds.
- (5) All equipment operated under the authority of this license are limited to interrogation Modes 1, 2, 3A and 3C. No Mode 4 interrogations are authorized.
- (6) The antenna of all equipment operating on 1030 MHz under the authority of this license (antenna at 405148N/0732227W) shall be oriented towards the 1090 MHz transmitter (located at 405150N/0732231W) that is also authorized on this license.
- (7) The Mode 3A code for all equipment operating on 1090 MHz shall be 5117 and the Mode 3C response shall be 600 feet below ground level or greater than 60,000 feet above mean sea level.
- (8) The antenna of all equipment operating on 1090 MHz under the authority of this license (antenna at 405150N/0732231W) shall be oriented towards the 1030 MHz transmitter (at 405148N/0732227W) that is also authorized on this license.
- (9) All equipment used under the authority of this license will be in conformance with ICAO Aeronautical Telecommunications Annex 10.
