Ms. Nguyen:

In response to your e-mail dated July 16, 2013, this is to advise you of the following:

- FAA coordination has been requested but has not yet been completed. BAE Systems is continuing to follow-up with FAA staff regarding the status of the coordination, but the coordination has not yet been completed. As soon as FAA coordination is completed, BAE Systems will confirm same with you. In the meantime, it is respectfully requested that an additional 30 days be provided to allow FAA to complete its coordination report.
- BAE Systems is in the process of collecting specific contract information for the contract associated with the MAG frequencies on the license (228.6-328.6 MHz; 335.4-454 MHz) and will provide that information to you as soon as it has been collected. BAE Systems requests an extra 7 days to provide this information to ensure accuracy and completeness. With respect to this question, BAE Systems reiterates its request as stated in the renewal application that the Station Class be changed from "XC" to "XD" to permit operation under the license for internal research and development activity in addition to the supported contract activity.
- AFTRCC coordination:
 - o VHF coordination of 123.250 MHz has been completed. A scan of this coordination has been attached to an email directly to you, and the report has been uploaded as an attachment to the pending renewal file.
 - o AFTRCC coordination of the telemetry bands is still ongoing and has not yet been completed. AFTRCC has recommended that additional time be allowed to permit completion of the coordination, as AFTRCC is still waiting for a reply from DoD. Accordingly, it is respectfully requested that an additional 30 days be provided to allow AFTRCC to complete its coordination report for the telemetry frequencies. BAE Systems will submit proof of AFTRCC telemetry coordination as soon as it is received.
- ASRI coordination has been completed. A scan of this coordination has been attached to an email directly to you, and the report has been uploaded as an attachment to the pending renewal file.
- BAE Systems understands that use of the 700 MHz band under the license will require FirstNet consent. BAE Systems requests that the 700 MHz frequencies on the license be retained, and a Special Condition be added to the license addressing the need for FirstNet consent, to allow BAE Systems the opportunity in the future to seek FirstNet consent if use of these frequencies is required in the future.
