In further reply to your request for FAA coordination dated 11/15/13 (Ref. No. 22026), this is to advise you of the following:

BAE Systems is still waiting for FAA to complete coordination of the following frequencies: 109.325 MHz, 109.375 MHz, 111.575 MHz, 113.825 MHz, 114.95 MHz, 116.1 MHz, 117.275 MHz (you previously confirmed that coordination was not necessary for the 940.4-1200 MHz band, because the license for Station WF2XUB does not contain any frequencies within this band. On 12/11/13, BAE Systems requested additional time to allow FAA to complete coordination of these frequencies. On 1/7/2014, 1/31/2014 and 2/27/2014, BAE Systems requested additional time to allow FAA to complete this coordination.
