- (3) Operation must exclude the following frequency band: 13.36-13.41 MHz, 25.55-25.67 MHz, 73-74.6 MHz, 608-614 MHz, 1400-1427 MHz, and 1660.5-1668.4 MHz.

- (5) Licensee must get consent from Educational Broadband Service and Advanced Wireless licensees prior to operating on 2586.95 MHz and 2000 MHz,
