- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) The station identification requirements of Section 5.115 of the Commission's Rules are waived.

Special Conditions:

- (4) Operation is subject to prior coordination with the Society of Broadcast Engineers, Inc. - (5) Under no circumstances is the ERP to exceed 182 Watts.
- (6) The applicant agrees to accept and implement any future modifications to their operation as directed by the FAA to include ceasing operations, or adding additional frequency restrictions so that future FAA operational requirements can be supported.
- (7) Operation is NOT permitted on the frequency band 4300 MHz due to potential interference to Federal operations.
