- (1) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.

Special Conditions:

- (3) Operation is subject to prior coordination with FAA.
- (4) This authorization is issued for the express purpose of conducting experimental operations described in the related application and required by NAVAIR, N00019-15-C-0038. The use of this radio station in any other manner or for any other purpose will constitute a violation of the privileges herein authorized. Except as subsequently authorized by the Commission, this radio station shall not be operated after the expiration date of the contract designated in the related application and enumerated above.
- (5) The Stop Buzzers, George Moynihan - 603-689-8630 and BAE Systems Emergency Services Center - 603-885-3842.
- (6) Transmission will be a single pulse with 265 micro-second pulse width.
- (7) For 1025-1035 MHz and 1087-1093 MHz, ERP is limited to 1W with a PRF of 1.
- (8) The 25 dBi gain parabolic antenna should be pointed 190 degrees referenced to true North.
- (9) Licensee shall notify the FAA Spectrum Management Office of each and every OE-120()/UPX antenna sell off event at least one week prior to the event and provide current contact information for the event. The FAA contact points are Mr. Rodney Murphy (RODNEY.MURPHY@FAA.GOV) and Mr. Don Nellis (DONALD.NELLIS@FAA.GOV)
- (10) The FAA will not extend the use of the 1030 and 1090 MHz.
- (11) Bae Systems is willing to accept the same conditions that were recently imposed by FAA.
- (12) Any changes to the transmit antenna for 1025-1035 MHz and 1087-1093 MHz will require recoordination with the FAA and require the user to provide the full radiation pattern; which includes (360-degree) azimuth pattern and elevation pattern.
- (13) Any changes of US contract and technical parameters will require to submit the modification application.
