

**BAE Systems Information and
Electronic Systems Integration Inc.**

Notification Pursuant to 47 C.F.R. §5.77

As the Commission is aware, BAE Systems Information and Electronic Systems Integration Inc. (“BAE Systems”) is authorized to operate experimental facilities pursuant to Special Temporary Authority issued under File No. 0098-EX-ST-2008 (the “Grant”).¹ In the Grant, BAE Systems is authorized to operate the facilities pursuant to a “NON” emissions designator. By this Notification, BAE Systems hereby advises the Commission that it intends to operate certain of the authorized frequencies using additional emission designators, as follows:

Additional Designator – 32K0F7E; Applicable Freqs. – 1555.844-1556.438 MHz
Additional Designator – 4K00F3E; Applicable Freqs. – 228.8-328.6 MHz;
335.4-454 MHz

In accordance with the requirements of 47 C.F.R. §5.77(a) and (b), BAE Systems hereby confirms that the addition of these emissions designators will not result in operations inconsistent with any term of the outstanding authorization issued under File No. 0098-EX-ST-2008, and all operations will remain subject to the Special Conditions imposed in File No. 0098-EX-ST-2008. The addition of these emissions designators will not result in BAE Systems exceeding the maximum emissions envelope and radiated power level established in the existing authorization under File No. 0098-EX-ST-2008. In this regard, BAE Systems recognizes the previously-authorized band edges, and will contain the modulated signal within the previously granted band edges.

Should the Commission have any questions or concerns regarding this Notification and the utilization of the specified additional emissions designators in connection with this grant, please notify BAE Systems. In the absence of such notification, BAE Systems will proceed with such operation based on the representations in this Notification.

¹ An application for a two year experimental license has been filed under File No. 0484-EX-PL-2008, seeking authority for the facilities previously granted under File No. 0098-EX-ST-2008. The application for a two year license remains pending under File No. 0484-EX-PL-2008. As such, under FCC rules and policies BAE Systems has continuing authority to operate under the parameters issued pursuant to File No. 0098-EX-ST-2008.
