- Pending File No. 0029-EX-ST-2007 (filed 2/02/2007) (Hudson, NH)

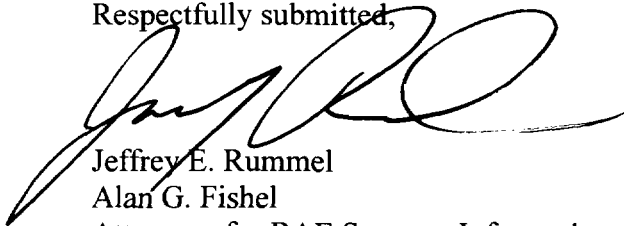
