In response to your e-mail to Mr. Tracy Johnson dated 1/21/09, and as a follow-up to the reply previously submitted on 2/19/09, this is to report the following:

1) FAA coordination of the application remains pending. The regional FAA coordinator has been out of the office and is not expected back in the office until March 4. In the meantime, the applicant has requested FAA headquarters to proceed with coordination of the application in the absence of the regional coordinator - but the applicant has not received confirmation as to whether FAA HQ has been able to complete the coordination. Because the completion of FAA coordination remains outside the control of the applicant, it is respectfully requested that some additional time be allowed to permit completion of coordination after the regional FAA coordinator returns to work on or around March 4.
