Ms. Nguyen:

In follow-up to my e-mails dated 11/30/11 and 12/26/11, and in further reply to your e-mail dated November 2, 2011, this is to confirm that FAA coordination is still not complete.

BAE Systems remains in regular contact with FAA regarding this coordination, and in fact the company spoke directly with the FAA processor today and was advised that coordination has not yet been completed recently because the processor was out of the office for the last 6 weeks. In addition, the processor advised that repairs to the FAA processor's office are further preventing completion of coordination. The FAA processor has confirmed that he is aware of the coordination request and has confirmed that he will address completion of the coordination as soon as he is able to.

In light of the fact that BAE Systems is continuing to work with FAA to complete coordination, an additional 20 days is requested to complete FAA coordination.

BAE Systems will submit proof of FAA coordination as soon as it is received.
