Mr. Serafini:

In reply to your e-mail to Mr. Henry Bachman dated December 7, 2007, this is to advise you of the following:

BAE Systems very much appreciates your comments concerning the scope of the frequency requests in this application, and the applicant has reviewed this matter carefully. As I have subsequently discussed with Mr. Burtle, for engineering and programmatic reasons, BAE Systems would prefer to retain the frequency requests currently identified in the application. Authorization of experimental test frequencies in the bands specified in the application will provide FCC authority most consistent with our test requirements. Mr. Burtle indicated that this approach would be acceptable. Please let me know if there are any remaining concerns with the frequency requests.

As I further explained to Mr. Burtle, BAE Systems understands that retention of the frequency requests as currently identified will require NTIA processing and coordination.

Finally, Mr. Burtle has advised me that he has approved the Expedite Request. Accordingly, if the STA Request has not yet been transmitted to NTIA for processing, we would greatly appreciate your transmitting it to NTIA, so that coordination can begin as promptly as possible.
