

NOTIFICATION

By this Notification, BAE Systems Information and Electronic Systems Integration Inc. ("BAE Systems") hereby advises the Commission that, for the authorized frequencies under File No. 0593-EX-ST-2005¹ within 228.8-328.6 MHz and 335.4-454 MHz, the licensee intends to operate under such authority using an additional emission designator, namely, "5M00G1W", in order to address certain additional requirements related to this experiment.

In accordance with the requirements of 47 C.F.R. §5.77(a) and (b), BAE Systems hereby confirms that the addition of this emissions designator will not result in operations inconsistent with any term of the outstanding authorization issued to the company. In addition, the addition of this emissions designator will not result in BAE Systems exceeding the maximum emissions envelope and radiated power level established in the existing authorization.

Should the Commission have any questions or concerns regarding this Notification and the utilization of the additional emissions designator 5M00G1W in connection with this grant, please notify BAE Systems. In the absence of such notification, BAE Systems will proceed with operation based on the representations in this Notification.

¹ An application for a two year experimental license has been filed under File No. 0147-EX-PL-2006, seeking authority for the facilities previously granted under File No. 0593-EX-ST-2005. The application for a two year license remains pending under File No. 0147-EX-PL-2006. As such, under FCC rules and policies BAE Systems has continuing authority to operate under the parameters issued pursuant to File No. 0593-EX-ST-2005.
