I have contacted our LDO and verified for the next six months we will be testing at the Wallops Island test range for the East Coast and our upcoming tests at Naval Air Station North Island. We have been granted a onetime test event authorization at NASA/WFF by the spectrum manager of that test range. Additionally we are in the process of requesting and filling out the required spectrum management forms for North Island (NASNI).
