Mr. Kennedy,

This application is to supplement the granted experimental license file number 0317-EX-ST-2003, Call Sign WB9XVA This application is also for power testing a U.S. Navy system under development here at BAE SYSTEMS. It will be a short term test, on the order of a few days, with radiating periods up to 60 minutes. I require only discrete frequencies. I would like two frequencies, one somewhat near 5 GHz, one somewhat near 7.5 GHz. I can be very flexible as to what specific frequencies I use. The second frequency should be less than 7.5 GHz, could be as low as 6 GHz. The first frequency could be down to 4.5 GHz or even lower if necessary. I just need something near the mid and high points of my band to test power handling of the system. I could use an allocation as soon as possible. Thank you.

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
