This refers to application, File No. 0037-EX-PL-2001, for Experimental Radio Station WC2XOP.

Such rejection should include a statement of the reasons, if any, why the applicant believes that the application should be granted in accordance with the terms requested therein.

You are advised that the Commission was unable to make a finding that the public interest would be served by a grant of the application in the manner requested. Operations in the 1559-1610 MHz band are denied due to potential interference to GPS. Operations in the bands 1710-1850 MHz and 2320-2360 MHz are denied due to potential interference to FAA operations.
