To Whom It May Concern:

This statement is in response to a message received today with confirmation number EL11115, requesting an explanation for why BeamReach Networks is asking for experimental authorization over the Continental United States and for the ERP values for the frequency bands requested.

BeamReach Networks intends to conduct simultaneous trials of its equipment with customers in multiple locations in the United States. In addition, BeamReach Networks intends to demonstrate this equipment at trade shows which occur at various times around the country. Rather than file a large number of individual requests for experimental authorization and special temporary authorization for the trial locations and numerous trade shows, it was deemed a single application requesting authorization over a large geography would be less of a burden on the Commission.

BeamReach Networks is developing broadband wireless point to multipoint equipment. Neither the base stations nor the subscriber stations are utilized in a mobile fashion (i.e., both must be bolted in place prior to operation). The ERP values are as follows:

Base Station 137 W

Subscriber Station 33 W
