RE: Request for Special Temporary Authorization

Dear Sir or Madam:

Benjamin Hebron ("Licensee") and Chadmoore Communications, Inc. ("Manager"), manager of Licensee's 800 MHz Specialized Mobil Radio ("SMR") service license in the Memphis, TN area, hereby request Special Temporary Authorization ("STA") pursuant to Section 5.56 of the Commission's rules for an experimental effort consisting of transmission of radio dispatch operations to assist Memphis Medical Center in upgrading their current vital communications system. Licensee and requests that authority be granted immediately for a period not to exceed sixty (60) days to allow Licensee and Manager to operate previously existing authorized stations on the premises of Memphis Medical Center to perform signal tests and modifications to the communications system to attempt to meet Memphis Medical Center's unique and vital communications needs.

Manager is an established SMR service provider in the Memphis, TN area. Memphis Medical Center is a medical health facility in the Memphis, TN area providing critical and imperative health, safety and crisis services. Memphis Medical Center is in immediate need of upgrading its current communications facilities. Effective communications is paramount to the ability of Memphis Medical Center to provide essential operations to the general public.

The temporary operation of the currently authorized station from the Memphis Medical Center's facilities will allow testing of communications technology alternatives in conjunction with Memphis Medical Center's unique and crucial requirements. Grant of this Request would allow Licensee and Manager to test the communications systems and evaluate the system in light of Memphis Medical Center's needs. Grant of this Request would serve the public interest by facilitating the development of vital communications required by Memphis Medical Center to facilitate the provision of its critical services. Licensee respectfully seeks affirmative action on this Request as soon as possible so that it can further develop and meet the demands and requests of this

entity providing such critical services. Licensee and Manager are preparing to do special testing to determine the viability of the communications system. If the testing proves the communications system satisfactory to Memphis Medical Center and its needs, modification applications shall be provided to permanently modify the facilities.

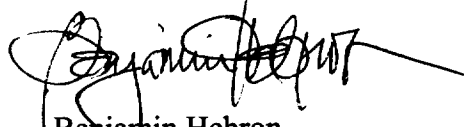
In accordance with Section 5.56 of the Commission rules, Licensee submits the following information:

- 2) See above regarding need for special action.
- 3) Trunked SMR.
- 4) Licensee and Manager will perform analysis of signal propagation in and around the facilities of the Memphis Medical Center in order to upgrade its communications system.
- 5) Licensee is seeking Special Temporary Authorization commencing April 24, 2000 and not to exceed sixty (60) days from the date of grant.
- 6) Licensee seeks to test the following 800 MHz SMR stations:
Call sign: WPDB627
Class of stations: FB2C
Nature of service: GX
- 7) The proposed operation shall be conducted at the Memphis Medical Center Building located at coordinates N35-08-33/W90-01-54.
- 8) Licensee and Manager will be operating one (1) Uniden MRZ-804 repeater. Licensee has a license for the repeaters in its licensed location in Memphis, TN, but does not have a license for the Memphis Medical Center Building location.
- 9) Licensee seeks to utilize the following frequency: WPDB677 – 854.5625.
- 10) The ERP will be 130 watts.
- 11) The emission type will be 20K0F3E.
- 12) The overall height of antenna structure above ground will be 30 meters.

Licensee submits this Request and affirms that no party to this application is ineligible for federal benefits pursuant to the Anti-Drug Abuse Act of 1998, 21 U.S.C. § 853(a). A check for Forty-Five Dollars (\$45.00) is attached hereto with FCC Form 159 to serve as the appropriate filing fee and form.
