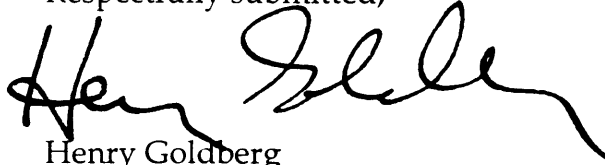
On March 12, 2003, the undersigned, accompanied by Messrs. Mark Johnson and Robert Leong of Biotronik, Inc. ("Biotronik"), and Mr. William Gamble, a consultant to Biotronik, met with Messrs. James Burtle, John Kennedy, Julius Knapp, and Bruce Romano of the Office of Engineering and Technology to discuss the above-referenced equipment authorization proceeding.

During the meeting representatives of Biotronik provided an oral description of the Philos DR-T medical implant device subject to the equipment authorization, matching written descriptions of the device previously provided to the Commission in this proceeding. Additional issues discussed were the resiliency of the Philos DR-T device to interference from the Meteorological Aids service (Met aids) and the need for Biotronik to submit a request for waiver of MICS rules with respect to the periodic transmissions the device employs.
