Special Conditions:

- (1) All customers participating in the experiment shall be informed that this operation is for experimental purposes only and can be cancelled at any time.
- (2) Licensee should be aware that other stations may be licensed on these frequencies and if any interference occurs, the licensee of this authorization will be subject to immediate shut down.
- (3) In lieu of frequency tolerance, the occupied bandwidth of the emission shall not extend beyond the band limits set forth above.
- (4) Consult the ULS database to ensure that the proposed tests will not cause adverse effect to any existing registered stations in the 3650-3700 MHz band and notify registered users in the immediate geographic area prior to operating in the 3650 - 3700 MHz band.
- (5) Prior to the start of operations in the 3650 -3700 MHz band, the company must notify Comsearch by e-mail. This notice must include the name and contact information of the stop buzzer personnel. It must also include the testing parameters, day and times of each testing.

- (6) Prior to the start of operations in the 3650 -3700 MHz band, the company must notify all the earth stations in band and adjacent band (3700-4200 MHz) within 15 km of their operations by e-mail. This notice must include the name and contact information of the stop buzzer personnel in order to notify the test equipment operator(s) to shut down in case of interference. The notification should also include the testing parameters and the day and times of each test. Consult MyIBFS database to identify all existing registered earth stations in band (3650-3700 MHz) and adjacent band (3700-4200 MHz).
- (7) Prior to operation in the 3650-3700 MHz frequency band, experimental licensee must maintain a separation distance of 150 km from the grandfathered earth stations as defined in Part 90 subpart Z. If operations are within 150 km from the grandfathered earth stations then experimental licensee must notify potentially-affected grandfathered earth stations licensee(s) and obtain a mutual agreement. - (8) The applicant must coordinate with the Fixed Microwave Service licensees in each proposed venue in accordance with 47 C.F.R, Part 101.103(d) prior to operation in the frequency range from 3700 MHz to 3800 MHz.
