Request for Confidential Treatment Under FCC Rules

BlackVe, Inc., hereby requests Confidential treatment for the following exhibits (the "Confidential Exhibits") to the above-referenced application:

-Technical Description
-ODAR

The Confidential Exhibits contain sensitive commercial proprietary information regarding BlackVe, Inc.'s proposed satellite operations and systems, including information on the operational parameters of its in-orbit systems, detailed trajectory and safety analysis, and the retrieval of payloads from orbit. Such information falls within Section 0.457(d) of the Commission's rules, as well as Exemption 4 of the Freedom of Information Act ("FOIA"), and thus should not routinely be made available for public inspection. Exemption 4 of FOIA provides that the statute's public disclosure requirement "does not apply to matters that are (4) trade secrets and commercial or financial information obtained from a person and privileged or confidential." The Confidential Exhibits should be afforded confidentiality under Exemption 4 because it is sensitive commercial information, some of which was developed solely for purposes of the application. Such material customarily would not be released to the public by BlackVe, Inc., and its release would cause substantial harm to the BlackVe, Inc.'s competitive position.

While BlackVe, Inc. believes that the confidential nature of the commercial information included in the Report automatically qualifies this submission as the type of record not routinely available for public inspection under Section 0.457(d) of the FCC's rules, BlackVe, Inc. out of an abundance of caution also alternatively requests that this material be withheld from public inspection pursuant to Section 0.459, although by the terms of that rule, such a request should be "unnecessary." BlackVe, Inc. seeks confidential treatment for the enclosed commercially sensitive information. This information is being provided to the Commission only, and BlackVe, Inc. has taken great care to prevent its unauthorized disclosure to unaffiliated third parties. None of the confidential information included in the Confidential Exhibits currently is available to the public, and the information is not disclosed to third parties in the ordinary course of business.
