

EXHIBIT #1: Information about FCC license request for New Shepard Flight 10

Re: STA file # 1638-EX-ST-2018

This license request is for a modification of the STA file # 0911-EX-ST-2018, call sign WM9XJC. There are two changes between 0911-EX-ST-2018 and this application, 1638-EX-ST-2018:

- Center frequencies changed to 2211 & 2272.5 MHz, to match FCC/NTIA preferred values
- Addition of 5 MHz emission bandwidths to existing 4 MHz emissions (5 MHz maximum as specified in FCC 13-65)

If it is not feasible to grant 5 MHz emission bandwidths at both 2211 and 2272.5, then Blue Origin Texas requests a grant of 4 MHz at 2211 MHz and 5 MHz at 2272.5 MHz (or vice versa). If it is not feasible to grant 5 MHz bandwidth at either center frequency, Blue Origin Texas requests FCC advise us so we can modify the application to inquire about other frequencies where a 5 MHz bandwidth may be feasible.
