Special Conditions:

- (3) POINT OF COMMUNICATION: Iridium's NGSO (non-geostationary orbit space stations) satellites (call sign S2110).
- (4) Licensee is authorized to operate station(s) in the 1618.725-1626 MHz frequency band via Iridium's NGSO satellites for mobile-satellite service on an exclusive basis.
- (5) Use of the 1618.725-1626 MHz frequency band is subject to Section 25.213 and footnote 5.372 of the Table of Frequency Allocation, which require protection of stations in the radio astronomy service operating in the band 1610.6-1613.8 MHz band.
- (6) Experimental station shall use the minimum power level necessary to establish communications links to minimize potential interference to licensed users
- (7) This authorization is without prejudice to any determination that the Commission may make regarding pending or future experimental satellite earth station applications.
