Concurrence from NTIA.

NTIA has no objection to the Boeing Company STA at Moses Lake, WA from May 20, 2005 thru August 15, 2005 under the following conditions:

- 1.) M75.0: Navaid used at Mose Lake, Coordinate with Seattle Center and POCC for use between 12 Midnight and 0400
- 2.) M1030: Concur provided that the interrogation rate is below 200 interrogations per second, the system complies with ICAO Annex 10 Vol4 standards, and do not include Mode-4, Mode-5, or Mode-S interrogation formats.
- 3.) M1090: The equipment either only replies to 1030 MHZ interrogations or does not provide more than 10 originated transmissions and the format of the 1090 MHZ emissions complies with ICAO Annex 10 standards, and the altitude information is set to either below sea level or above 60K feet.
- 4.) NTIA has no objection/conditions for the remaining frequencies.
