This Special Temporary Authorization is granted upon the express condition that it may be terminated by the Commission at any time without advance notice or hearing if in its discretion the need for such action arises. Nothing contained herein shall be construed as a finding by the Commission that the authority herein granted is or will be in the public interest beyond the express terms hereof.

This Special Temporary Authorization shall not vest in the grantee any right to operate the station nor any right in the use of the frequencies designated in the authorization beyond the term hereof, nor in any other manner than authorized herein. Neither the authorization nor the right granted hereunder shall be assigned or otherwise transferred in violation of the Communications Act of 1934. This authorization is subject to the right of use of control the Government of the United States conferred by Section 706 of the Communications Act of 1934.

- (2) In the band 2-27.5 MHz only those frequencies assigned to the U.S. Coast Guard should be used. Bollinger Shipyards needs to coordinate with the US Coast Guard District Office to obtain a list of these frequencies.
- (3) In the band 118-137 MHz use only these three frequencies approve by FAA: 118.4 MHz, 127.75 MHz and 136.6 MHz. Bollinger Shipyards must notify Mr. Gary Winsper at 817-222-4762 when the test will start.
- (4) In the band 156-162 MHz only those frequencies assigned to the U.S. Coast Guard should be used. Bollinger Shipyards needs to coordinate with the US Coast Guard District Office to obtain a list of frequencies. These frequencies may include wideband emissions (16 kHz) since the band has not been designated narrowband as of this time.
- (5) In the band 162-174 MHz only those frequencies assigned to the U.S. Coast Guard should be used. Bollinger Shipyards needs to coordinate with the US Coast Guard District Office to obtain a list of frequencies. These frequencies may include wideband emissions (16 kHz) since narrowbanding is not mandatory until January 1, 2005.
- (6) In the band 225-400 MHz use only these three frequencies approved by the FAA: 229.4 MHz, 310.8 MHz and 379.175 MHz. Bollinger Shipyards must notify Mr. Gary Winsper at 817-222-4762 when the test will start. In addition, those frequencies assigned to the U.S. Coast Guard can also be used. Bollinger Shipyards needs to coordinate with the US Coast Guard District Office to obtain a list of these frequencies.
