Please find attached our application and fee for stated frequency usage. We have an immediate need for the use of the frequency with our unmanned air vehicle system. The frequency is 1268 MHZ frequency at 10 watts. We have verified locally with U.S. Army post Ft. Fill's Director, Plans, Training, and Mobilization, that the frequency requested is not an interference with air traffic or range operations.

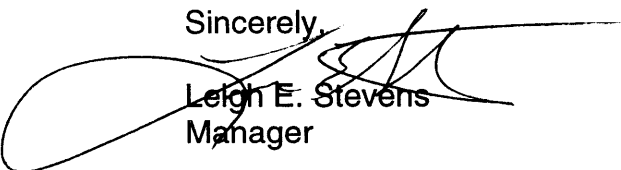
Ground testing is conducted at our facility east of interstate 44 in Lawton. Flight operations are conducted at Ft. Sill on the south side of the west range. From our southern location, flight operations are conducted in a fan north of our launch site usually within 10KM radius.

We are in preparation for a competitive bid on a board agency announcement. To better our position we need to fly during the proposal period. We believe that the data link frequency has been previously used with the U.S. Army's Hunter Unmanned Air Vehicle System (see exhibit 2).

We request that, to meet our operational needs for Oct 13, 1997, an interim frequency authorization be granted. We are prepared to pay any additional reasonable fees to facilitate our request. Please do not hesitate to contact Roy Remington or me at the above numbers.
