- (5) Operation is NOT permitted to use the frequencies 2210 MHz and 2234 MHz due to potential interference to Federal operations in the area.
- (6) Operation is subject to prior coordination with Fixed Services licensee(s) in the area.
- (7) This frequency assignment in one of the bands 1435-1525, 2310-2320 and 2345-2390 MHz was coordinated prior to authorization with the Eastern Area Frequency coordinator, Patrick AFB, Florida, who also coordinated it, as appropriate, with Aerospace and Flight Test Radio Coordinating Council. Use of this frequency under the authority of this assignment is subject to such further coordination with the Eastern AFC, Patrick AFB, Florida, as necessary to ensure compatibility with existing uses.
