- (3) The applicant must coordinate with the local Society of Broadcast Engineer frequency coordinator prior to operation on 455.825 MHz.
- (4) The applicant must have consents of the WCS "A" Block licensees (2305-2310 MHz/2350-2355 MHz) within 50 miles of the test area.
- (5) The band 2200-2290 MHz is allocate for federal satellite and fixed line of sight operations. Non-federal use is evaluated on a case-by-case basis.
- (6) Broad Comm should have no expectation of approval when request this band.
