

The 2006 Ford Tour de Georgia Bike Race will begin in Augusta, GA on Tuesday, April 18 and culminate the 650-plus miles of racing with its grand finale in Alpharetta, GA on Sunday, April 23, 2006. The six-day, six-stage race will pass through the following cities (geographic coordinates):

Airborne video coverage is to be provided from a maximum height of 900 feet above ground and the area of operation will be restricted to within a 10 mile (16 km) radius of the race course. AFTRCC coordination for airborne use of frequencies 1470, 1490, 2367 and 2384 MHz has been requested for the period from April 15, 2006 to April 23, 2006 to allow for setup and coverage of the race and associated events.
